Because we are now accepting many submissions from across the state, I felt it was important to put into writing, the copyright rules of the **Missouri Autism Report (MAR)**. The most important thing I ask is that if you submit a manuscript to the **MAR** for consideration, that you **not** publish it in another media, including websites or blogs, until after the manuscript has been published and/or printed in the **MAR**. This includes ANY story we are going to publish in our magazine. Our copyright rules are further discussed below. Thank you!

MAR Copyrights on purchased or trade-out stories or articles:

Stories or articles purchased for publication for a fee, or on trade-out agreement are owned exclusively by the **Missouri Autism Report (MAR)**, and may not be submitted elsewhere or posted online without express permission from the **MAR** at Dayna@MoAutismReport.com. Permission to republish articles online or in print form, may be obtained *upon request*, if proper reprint credits are stated in republished article. The **MAR** reserves the right to reprint stories and articles, at the discretion of the **MAR**, with writing credits given to all authors, just as they are given with their first printing in the **MAR**.

Reprint tagline should read: “Reprinted by permission of the Missouri Autism Report (MAR). First published in the (month, year) issue of the MAR and can be viewed at, www.MoAutismReport.com/newsletters/.”

Unpaid or non-trade stories or articles:

Stories or articles obtained for publication

to the **MAR**, without trade or fee agreement, are subject to First North American Serial Rights, in which the **MAR** reserves the right to *publish the document first* in the North American market. Publication of the material to blogs, websites or other print or online media forms, before publication of the article in the **MAR**, will be considered a breach of contract. After publication in the **MAR**, author may obtain “second serial rights” to publish in a blog, online publication, product spin-off, print media, etc. It is requested, out of courtesy, that reprinted articles, unless reworked, include this suggested tag-line, “**Previously published in the (month, year) issue of the Missouri Autism Report, www.MoAutismReport.com.**”

Second Rights and Photos:

If you send an article which has been published elsewhere, you must notify us of this fact so that the **MAR** can obtain proper release and credit information. All photos *must* be submitted with source information, so proper credit can given to photographer.
